She has a passion for social justice and has been involved in advocating for the rights of Indigenous peoples at local, national and international levels in human rights, law and justice, housing, consumer protection and culture and the arts.

She has attended three United Nations forums. At the time of her election to Congress, Tammy was the Managing Solicitor of the Law and Advocacy Unit of the Aboriginal Legal Service of WA, working on policy, law reform, community legal education, international law, prisoner support, coronial inquest preparation and verification of Aboriginality.

Tammy is also currently the Vice Chairperson of NAIDOC Perth and Shelter WA, a member of the Law Society of Aboriginal Lawyers Committee and a member of the National NAIDOC Committee (commencing August 2011).
